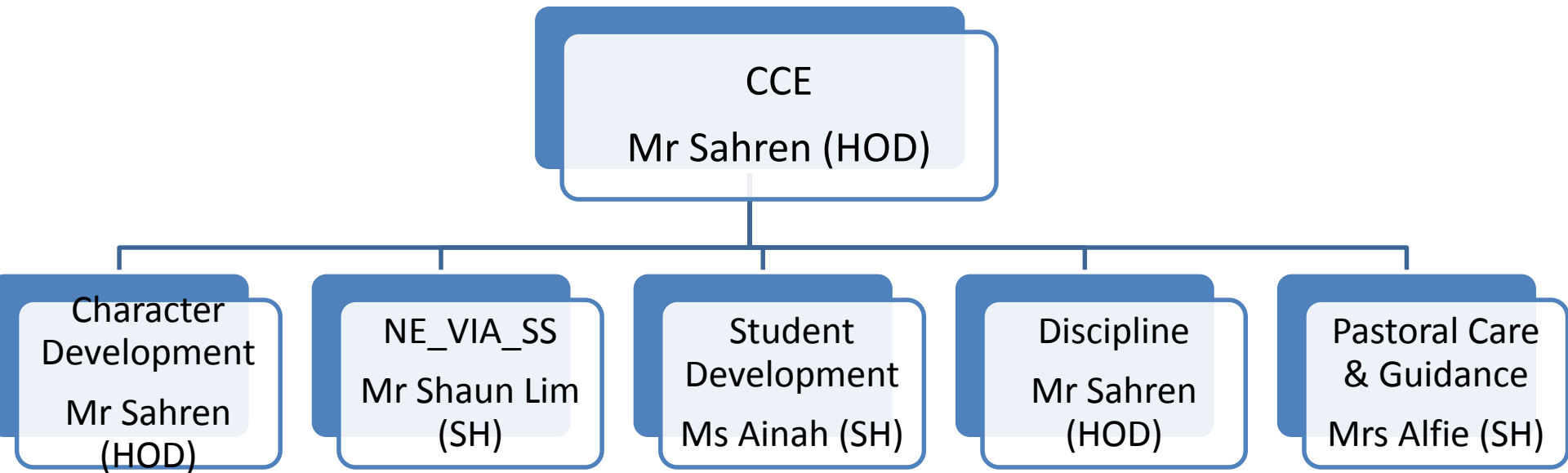
Goal of CCE:

After 1st day...



- Describe the 1st school day (name of buddy, FT, learning experience in the class, positive experiences)
- Discuss the school rules and regulations (for example, running around is not allowed and students should listen when the teacher is teaching)
- Always welcome them home with and compliment them!



Your Support



- Students to be **punctual** everyday (7.15am in the hall)
- After 7.30 am will be considered late.

Students taking transport:

- For students taking transport, ensure pick-up and drop-off location and timings
- Bus tags must be worn by students
- Inform bus attendant, teacher and child in case of special arrangement for the day

Your Support



Students to be fetched:

- For students to be fetched from school, try not to be late
- Anxiety, fear etc
- Must be fetched by an adult (if not inform FT via letter for documentation)

Your Support



Students who are not feeling well:

- Need to be fetched by an adult

Students who need to be fetched early:

- Letter must be given to the FT for documentation
- Must be fetched by an adult
