4. Assessment

There will be no examinations and weighted assessments at Primary 2. As students' learning for all subjects is based on a list of learning outcomes (LOs), teachers will leverage on formative assessments such as quizzes and performance tasks from Term 1 to check on students' understanding.

At the end of each semester, a 4-level qualitative descriptors such as Beginning, Developing, Competent and Accomplished, will be used to report on students' learning progress in the various subjects.

Students' learning progress will also be documented in the Portfolio folder to allow students to take ownership of their learning and development. This folder will showcase students' self-selected pieces, compilation of their learning feedback via checklists, rubrics and performance tasks for each semester.

5. Level Programmes

Enrichment Programme and Habits of Mind (HOM)

Enrichment Programme in Term 1 will focus on equipping students with essential ICT skills to enable learning with technology. Students will also be equipped with good learning habits and thinking dispositions which will enable them to become Self-Directed Learners. Students will be taught four Habits of Mind (HOM); *Questioning and Posing Problems, Thinking about Thinking, Applying Past Knowledge to New Situations and Thinking Flexibly* through hands-on activities and cognitive games to understand what each habit looks like, sounds like, feels like and applications of these habits in school and at home.

We would like to invite you to use the following phrases to encourage your child to apply these 4 habits at home:

- *What if...?* (Questioning and Posing Problems)
- *This is the same as...* (Applying Knowledge to New Situations)
- *Why did you do that?* (Thinking about Thinking)
- *How about thinking from another view?* (Thinking Flexibly)

School-Parent Meeting (SPM) & Class-Parent Meeting (CPM)

In our effort to foster a positive home-school partnership, there will be an online School & Class Parent Meeting on Friday, 14 January 2022, from 4.00 pm - 5.30 pm. This is an opportunity for you to meet up with the Year Head and Form Teachers who will share on level programmes, classroom practices and support that you could give to your child. We strongly encourage all parents to attend as we truly look forward to partner you in supporting and nurturing your child holistically. In view of the Safe Management Measures (SMM) in school, the meeting will be conducted via Zoom. More details including the Zoom meeting links will be shared with you via Parents Gateway (PG) on Friday, 7 January 2022.

6. Edusave Merit Bursary (EMB) and Edusave Good Progress Award (GPA) Eligibility Criteria

All Primary 2 Singaporean students in Government and Government-aided schools can be nominated for the EMB at the end of the school year, if they meet the following criteria:

- a. Consistently demonstrated positive learning dispositions in the course of the year; and
- b. Demonstrated good conduct.

All Primary 2 Singaporean students in Government and Government-aided schools who do not qualify for the EMB can be nominated for the GPA, if they meet the following criteria:

- a. Showed the greatest improvement in learning dispositions in the course of the year; and
- b. Demonstrated good conduct.

7. Parents Gateway (PG)

Do read the announcements in Parents Gateway regularly to be kept updated of school programmes and events, and make consent.

8. Daily Temperature-taking Exercise

Please ensure your child has a working thermometer and bring it to school daily as the school continues with daily temperature-taking in the classroom every morning.

9. Daily Snack Break (10 minutes) in class

There will be a short-break of 10 minutes, between 12.00 pm to 12.30 pm, for students to consume a simple snack. You are strongly encouraged to prepare a healthy snack of biscuits or a bun for your child to bring to school to consume during the short break.

10. School Dismissal
