Here is an update of the activities in Term 2.

**1. Assessments**

Please be reminded that a **medical certificate** is required in the event that your child is absent from the above assessments. Absence from all examinations must be supported by a medical certificate. Failure to produce a valid medical certificate will render a zero mark scored. We regret to inform you that letters of excuse will not be accepted. As such we appeal to you to ensure that your child is fit and healthy in order for him/her to perform well in the assessments.

There will be no re-tests except for English and Mother Tongue Oral. If your child is unwell on the day of the oral examination **and** has a medical certificate, the EL or MT teacher will arrange for your child/ward to retake the oral examination on another day.

**2. Direct School Admission (DSA)**

As shared with parents in the termly letter for term 1 as well as during the School-Parents Meeting held last term, parents were informed that P6 students can seek admission to certain secondary schools based on their talent in sports, aesthetics, leadership, CCAs and specific academic areas. **3. Remedial / Supplementary Lessons**

This term, remedial and supplementary classes will be suspended. Parents will be informed via Parents Gateway if there are any changes.

**4. National Primary Fitness Assessment (NAPFA) Test**

Every year, the National Primary Fitness Assessment (NAPFA) test will be conducted and for this year, the static stations assessment will take place within curriculum time. During the PE lessons prior to the test, the pupils will be given various conditioning sessions. Further details will be released by your child/ward's PE teacher.

**5. The Growing Years Programme**

This programme will take place during school curriculum hours on Friday, 22 May 2020. Students will be equipped with life skills to handle issues that he/she may face in his/her growing up years.
