Absence from all examinations must be supported by a medical certificate. Failure to produce a valid medical certificate will render a zero mark scored. We regret to inform you that letters of excuse will not be accepted. As such we appeal to you to ensure that your child is fit and healthy in order for him/her to perform well in the assessments.

There will be no re-tests except for English and Mother Tongue Oral. If your child is unwell on the day of the oral examination <u>and</u> has a medical certificate, the EL or MT teacher will arrange for your child/ward to retake the oral examination on another day.

# 2. Direct School Admission (DSA)
