

Objectives



Guidelines for PSG members

- 1. Membership of the PSG Committee is opened to:
 - Parents of current students of BLGPS
 - Parents of former students of BLGPS
- 2. Members are to serve a minimum of one (1) year term.
- Members to be the ambassadors for the school and PSG.
- 4. Members are required to wear the PSG Pass while in the school premise and for all school activities unless otherwise specified.
- 5. Members to support the school's policy and provide input where necessary.
- 6. The Committee shall meet at least once a term. Other meetings may be convened whenever it may be considered necessary by the Chairman or the school. Agenda of the meetings shall be notified to all members at least 1 week prior to the date of the meeting.
- 7. Members attending school programmes and events are required to sign in and out at the Guard House.


