PRIMARY FOUR LEVEL MATTERS – TERM 3

We are very excited about the upcoming Term 3 and would like to take this opportunity to share with you and your child what to expect for this term.

4. Level Programmes

Remedial/Supplementary/Enrichment Class

The teachers will inform your child and you accordingly via Parents Gateway if your child is selected to attend any remedial/supplementary or enrichment class. We strongly urge all parents to assist in ensuring your child attends the lessons regularly in order to fully benefit from it academically.

P4 Science Virtual Learning Journey

All Primary 4 students are strongly encouraged to participate in the Science Virtual Learning Journey. The programme will be conducted via live video conference by the Singapore Science Centre and students will be joining the video conference in their respective classrooms. The programme aims to supplement classroom teaching by providing students with a deeper understanding of the concept of 'Light'. In the workshop, students will get to explore the nature of light and investigate how different mirrors, lenses and materials affect how light travels. The workshop will also cover aspects of colours, shadows, and light as a form of energy.

P4 National Education Heritage Virtual Learning Journey

All Primary 4 students are encouraged to take part in the NE Virtual Learning Journey to Chinatown. Supervised by teachers in class, the virtual learning journey will be conducted via

live-video conference by a guide and students will be joining the video conference in their respective classrooms. Through this, students will get to know more about the history, culture, traditions and customs brought about by the early Chinese immigrants. The learning journey will also allow students to know and appreciate Singapore's past and present and celebrate racial and religious harmony in Singapore.

P4 Conversational Chinese-Malay (CCM) Programme

The Conversational Chinese-Malay programme (CCM) is introduced as an enrichment programme for non-Chinese and non-Malay language learners. Those who have indicated their interest previously in Term 2 will be having zoom lessons at home on Tuesdays after curriculum time in Term 3 and Term 4.

Learning Conversational Chinese-Malay would provide these students with the facility to communicate with native speakers, and help students to enhance their rapport with their Chinese and Malay-speaking friends. The CCM programme is non-examinable.

P4 Financial Literacy Workshop

All Primary 4 students will be taking part in the Financial Literacy Workshop during curriculum time to learn key financial and economic concepts so as to inculcate good financial habits from young, and be equipped to make good financial decisions later in life. Through an array of engaging activities and simulations, students will learn to differentiate between needs and wants as well as good money habits and attitudes.

P4 Cyber Wellness Workshop

All Primary 4 students will be attending the Cyber Wellness Workshop where they will learn how to better balance their usage of the internet. Through the workshop, students will find out more about intrinsic and extrinsic motivation in using not just the Internet, but also applications on mobile devices such as games and social media. By the end of the workshop, students will be able to better assess their level of online usage and gain practical tips for self-regulation and healthy usage of the Internet and applications.

P4 Learning Buffet

Our P4 students will be taking part in an Education and Career Guidance (ECG) programme titled 'Learning Buffet'. P4 Learning Buffet will take place on 31 August this year during school hours. Students will get to learn through authentic hands-on activities and discussion with professionals in the various careers in the different career categories. Through this programme, we hope to encourage students' awareness of personal strengths and interests to guide exploration of career pathways. More importantly, we hope to inspire students to have beginning aspirations through exploration of various careers.

P4 CCA

In line with the national posture on the evolving COVID-19 situation and MOE guidelines, in-person CCA will resume only from Term 3 Week 5 (29 July) with adherence to national safe management guidelines. Instead, eCCA sessions will be conducted in Term 3 Week 2 – 4 to ensure continuity of learning. Students should refer to the eCCA portal for more information on their CCA activities.

We hope that this information will give you greater insight on how you can support your child this term. We look forward to continuing our efforts to foster a strong partnership with you.


