Please note that the Removal of Common Last Topics for PSLE 2021 was announced on 23 June 2021. More information can be found in MOE website (<https://www.moe.gov.sg/news/press-releases/20210623-updates-to-the-2021-national-examinations-and-resumption-of-co-curricular-activities-in-schools>).

Please also note that Preliminary Exam English Oral and MT Oral will be conducted after curriculum time. More details will be sent out nearer the date.

PSLE Oral Examination

The 2021 PSLE Oral Examination will be held over two days on Thursday, 12 August 2021 and Friday, 13 August 2021.

Please take note of the following for both Preliminary and PSLE examination:

Students will not be allowed to sit for any examinations if they:

- Have been tested positive for COVID-19,
- Are placed on Quarantine Order (QO) or Stay Home Notice,
- Are issued with Leave of Absence (LOA) due to close contact with confirmed case or as a result of staying in same household with individuals on QO,
- Are on medical leave due to Acute Respiratory Infection, or
- Are on Approved Absence, as a result of staying in same household with members (aged 6 and above) who have flu-like symptoms.

As PSLE oral exams are conducted over several days, students who miss the exams with valid reasons can take the exams on another date within the oral exam window where applicable or to sit for make-up oral exam.

As for Preliminary oral exam which is conducted over two days, students who miss the exam on the first day with valid reasons can take the exam on the second day.

Please be reminded that a medical certificate is required in the event that your child is unwell and absent on any of the examination days. The examination marks for students who are absent during examination and covered by Medical Certificates or any of the above valid reasons will be pro-rated. Absence without a valid Medical Certificate or valid reasons will render a zero mark scored. Letters of excuse will not be accepted.

3. Level Programmes

Remedial / Supplementary Lessons

The teachers will inform your child and you accordingly via Parents Gateway if your child is selected to attend any remedial/supplementary or enrichment class. We strongly urge all parents to assist in ensuring your child/ward attends the lessons regularly in order for them to fully benefit from it academically.

Academic Support Plan

CCA will be suspended for all Primary 6 students in Term 3. In preparation for PSLE, the school has put in place an academic support plan to support our P6 students in his/her learning on every Thursday from 1.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.

Extra classes will also be conducted during the last 2 days of the September holidays (9 Sep and 10 Sep 2021). Information regarding the extra classes will be uploaded via Parents Gateway nearer the date.

Tree Planting Day

As part of our school's Learning for Life Programme on Environmental Education and in support of Singapore's OneMillion Trees movement to restore nature back into our environment, our Primary 6 students will be taking part in a tree planting day activity on 19 July 2021. Through this activity, our students will learn more about environmental conservation and be encouraged to take an active role in the greening of Singapore.

4. Values Education

The focus on CAREs value for Term 3 is Respect. We encourage all Primary 6 students to understand the cultural, religious customs and practices of others as well as to show empathy in one's thoughts and actions.
