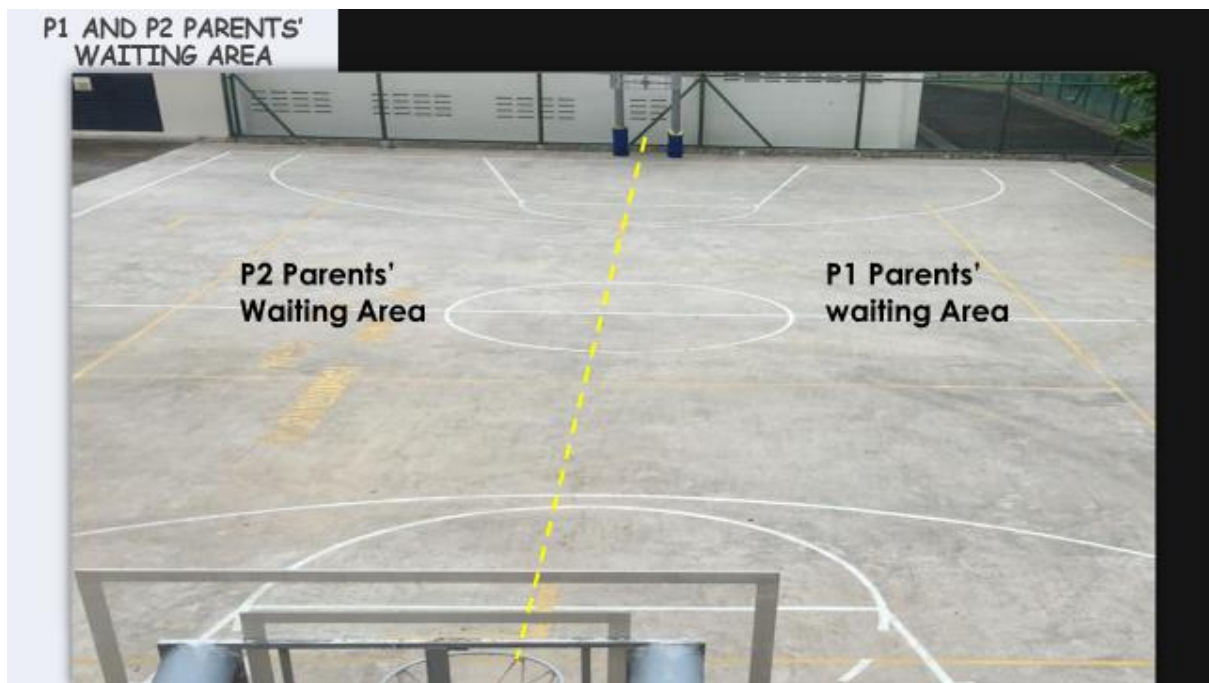
3. Staggered Dismissal

On normal days, the Basketball court is designated as the Parents Waiting Area. We request your cooperation on the following:

- Be punctual at 1.20pm
- Check in via the Trace Together-only SafeEntry at Gate 3 (*Gate next to Guardhouse*)
- Proceed to the left side of the Basketball court and wait in line according to your child's class
- Practise social distancing when waiting for your child
- Depart school premise via Gate 3 in an orderly fashion once your child is dismissed. Please refrain from standing in front of the gates and blocking the passageway.



On wet weather, please proceed to the Canteen to pick up your child.

4. Level Programme

Enriched Curriculum

In Term 2, students enhanced their ICT skills through touch typing and completed a task using the Word document. Students were also taught to use the SCAMPER tool when building their own games such as the Infinity Tiles and Maze.

In Term 3, students will participate in Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) speech and drama lessons to build their confidence, and strengthen their expressive speaking ability and interpersonal communication skills. Through engaging stories and role-playing, the programme also aims to bring joy of learning and develop in students the intrinsic motivation towards the learning of the Mother Tongue Languages.

Habits of Mind (HOM) Workshop

Students will be attending a workshop on these four Habits of Mind:

- Gathering Data through All Senses
- Responding with Wonderment and Awe
- Thinking and with Clarity and Precision
- Striving for Accuracy

Through this workshop, students will be taught to:

- Pay attention to their surrounding using all their senses
- Be curious about their learning
- Speak clearly and be confident about what they want to say
- Take pride in their work and check before submission

We would like you to use the following phrases to encourage your child to apply these four habits at home:

- *What do you see, hear and smell?* (Gathering Data through All Senses)
- *Wow! What do you think about this?* (Responding with Wonderment and Awe)
- *Why don't you try to say it clearly?* (Thinking and Communicating with Clarity and Precision)
- *Have you checked?* (Striving for Accuracy)

4. Values Education

The focus on CARES value for Term 3 is Respect for All. We encourage Primary Two students to demonstrate care for others in class and be able to remind classmates to respect others.

We hope that this information will give you greater insight on how you could support your child this term. We look forward to fostering a strong partnership with you.
