1. PSLE Examination Matters

Candidates who are tested positive for COVID-19 are not allowed to sit for the examination for the first 72 hours after tested ART positive. They are allowed to sit for exam

(a) if tested ART negative after 72 hours; or

(b) on Day 7 (for fully vaccinated candidates, and candidates below 12) or Day 14 (for partially vaccinated/unvaccinated candidates aged 12 or above), after 12pm.

On Medical Leave due to Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) / fever

Candidates who are unwell, especially if displaying respiratory symptoms such as runny nose, cough or sore throat, should see a doctor at a polyclinic or a designated General Practitioner (GP) clinic participating in the Swab-and-Send-Home (SASH) initiative, preferably in the morning.

Candidates who display symptoms less than four days before the examination, as well as in between different examination dates, should seek medical attention at polyclinics to ensure timely diagnosis.

Candidates will be allowed to sit for the examination if they are visibly well (no fever, not showing ARI symptoms).

2. Level Programmes

Remedial and Supplementary Lessons

Remedial Lessons

Remedial lessons will be conducted in Week 1 (beginning 12 September 2022) and Week 2 (23 September 2022) to address learning gaps. Subject teachers will inform your child and you accordingly via Parents Gateway if your child is selected to attend any remedial lessons. We strongly urge all parents to assist in ensuring your child attends the lessons regularly for them to fully benefit from it academically.

Supplementary Lessons

In preparation for PSLE, the Primary 6 students will be having supplementary class on Thursday, 22 September 2022 from 1.30 pm to 3.30 pm. CCA for Primary 6 students will resume in Week 5 (13 October 2022).

Study break in the lead up to PSLE Written Examination

To support students' well-being and minimise the risk of school-based transmission prior to the PSLE, MOE is implementing a study break for Primary 6 cohorts from Monday, 26 September to Wednesday, 28 September 2022. Students are not required to report to school on these 3 days.

If your child is identified to return to school during the study break, parents will be informed via Parents Gateway consent in Week 2.

Post-PSLE Examination Programme

The school has lined up a range of activities for our Primary 6 students to support them in their transition process to Secondary Schools and provide opportunities to explore their interests and talents. These post examination activities which are reflected in the Primary 6 Term 4 Calendar will take place during school hours from 10 October 2022 to 16 November 2022. Some of the exciting activities include Learning Buffet which aims to inspire students to have aspiration through exploration of various careers and Code for Fun programme which aims to develop students understanding of Computational Thinking and Programming.

P6 Growing Years Programme

This programme will be conducted during school curriculum hours on Monday, 10 October 2022. Students will be equipped with life skills to build healthy relationships online and exercise safety.

Primary 6 Home-based Learning (HBL) Days

The school is scheduling two HBL days for our Primary 6 students on 27 and 28 October 2022 to develop their ability to be self-directed, motivated, and life-long learners. During these two HBL days, students will be exploring topics outside the curriculum and learning will be asynchronous via the Student Learning Space (SLS). More information will be communicated to students nearer the date. Students who require a learning device may loan from the school.

Primary 6 Graduation Ceremony

To celebrate six years of Primary School Education as a level, the Primary 6 Graduation Ceremony will be held on Thursday, 17 November 2022 during school hours. It is also a platform for our students to showcase the talents that they have acquired over the course of their primary school educational journey.

As we bid farewell to our graduating class, we sincerely hope that they leave the school with the values and life skills that will put them in good standing for the rest of their lives.
